

## ABOUT THE DELIGHT

A short history of the delight was derivated from the Otoman word "rahatül – hüküm" which means "makes the throat "at ease" or "repose" or "comfortable ". Though lokum -delight- is known since The 15th. Century up to now in Anatolia, it had been spreaded in the borders of Otoman Empire especially during the 17th.Century. It had been let known as the name "Türk Lokumu": Turkish Delight in all around Europe by a British traveller during the 18th. Century.

Lokum which means Turkish Delight , had been made before using honey or grape treacle with flour combination . In 17. Century the delight had been made with the refined sugar and starch in Anatolia. Starch changed the production style and the taste of the delight.


